I appreciate the efforts of the board and staff in shaping the Scoping Plan. While much of the plan moves CA in a climate-positive direction, the final draft still contains elements that will have negative consequences. I strongly support the recommendations of the EJAC. My key concerns:

- * Engineered Carbon Capture: This strategy simply lets the fossil fuel industry continue making carbon-intensive products. Instead, the plan should only support natural carbon sequestration.
- * Refinery Pollution: The plan needs to account for all emissions, including those tied to use of all exported refinery products.
- * Public Health: The draft plan's health impact analysis is inadequate. Please establish a Public Health Advisory Group.
