Unregulated Locomotives in Urban Areas

- Small railyards in Southern California
- Typically located in Disadvantaged Communities
- Typically operate 1950's Locomotives
 - Not even Tier 0!!







Switching History of the 999

- The Zero Emissions RPS 999 has been intermittently active at a small California railyard for 3 years
- All RPS 999 operations have been in a DAC
 - 89% under Cal Enviroscreen 4.0
- Simple CORE voucher would put into daily service



- 2020 Jun-Dec
 - 48 shifts
- 2021
 - 10 shifts
- 2022 Jan-Nov
 - 24 shifts
- 2023 CORE Voucher
 - 150+ shifts
