Re: BizFed Supports ARB Staff Recommendation of Cal Poly Pomona Site for the Proposed Southern California Consolidation Project

Dear Board Members,

On behalf of BizFed, the Los Angeles County Business Federation – a grassroots alliance of over 150 top business groups representing 275,000 employers with 3 million employees throughout LA County - we are writing in support of your Staff's recommendation to relocate Southern California facilities to the proposed Cal Poly Pomona site.

Relocation to the Cal Poly Pomona campus brings not only greater opportunities for partner, stakeholder and visitor relations, but also will help ensure retention of 400 skilled jobs in the region because it will mean significantly less disruption to ARB employees' family life, daily commutes, and the environment.

ARB's own staff notes in its recommendation that proximity is a significant consideration and recognizes the Pomona site's advantages relative to supporting ARB's ability to carry out its responsibilities by minimizing travel distance and travel time.

" The proximity to the Los Angeles area minimizes the disruption to ARB staff, allows greater flexibility on where staff chooses to live, provides more flexibility for spouse/partner employment, and may facilitate recruitment and retention of staff in the future," staff writes in its recommendation. "The close proximity to the South Coast AQMD would encourage better coordination on a variety of policy and technical issues."

In addition, staff noted that approximately 85% of employees preferred the Pomona site - over Riverside - for a possible relocation facility, citing the shorter commute distance, time, and impacts on personal life and work.

For these reasons, we urge you to support the Cal Poly Pomona site for relocation. We thank you for your consideration and look forward to working with you on this project.
