Open Letter to Air Resources Board

Dear Chairman Nichols, Boardmembers, and staff of the Air Resources Board:

The Electric Vehicle Charging Association (EVCA) submitted comments on the Volkswagen Cycle 2 Investment Plan for consideration at your November meetings. In that letter, our company was referenced as a member of the organization, alongside criticisms of the plan.

I write you today to inform you that our company was not aware and not involved in drafting reviewing the letter from EVCA, and we strongly disagree with the position taken in that letter. There appears to have been a breakdown in process at EVCA, which we are investigating. We believe members should have been given the opportunity to object to a letter like this. Indeed, it appears that principally two of the member companies drafted this letter without input from others.

It is important to have a clear record in this matter. So to restate our position, I have attached the letter timely submitted on our behalf by Terry O'Day. Please feel free to reach me or Terry with any questions you may have.
