To ARB Board Members,

We are committed to participate with the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (SMAQMD) to implement the *Sacramento Regional Zero-Emission School Bus Deployment Project* for the California Air Resources Board (ARB) Zero-Emission Bus and Truck Pilot Program.

This project will help accelerate the deployment of commercially available heavy-duty, zero-emission, school buses and provide direct public benefits to Disadvantaged Communities throughout the Greater Sacramento Metropolitan Area. It will significantly reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and will provide economic and environmental benefits directly to our Disadvantaged Communities — while demonstrating the scalability, practicality and economic viability of wide-spread adoption of purpose-built, zero-emission school buses. Furthermore, it will help reduce criteria pollutants and provide public health cobenefits to both schoolchildren and the greater community.

- Provide the latest safety technology such as high back seats and seatbelts
- Provide opportunity for state-of-the-art equipment training for our maintenance staff

- Provide neighboring school districts to experience zero-emission technology by use of a loaner school bus
- Provide data analysis and direct comparison between CHP-certified, in-use diesel fueled and battery-electric school buses
- Provide state-of-the-art equipment training to high school and junior college students by creating collaborative partnerships between educational institutions
