Dear Chair Nichols:

We have been supportive of the Green Movement and the Air Resources Board diesel air toxic control measures. We have a "GREEN-STAR" certification from the National Ready Mix Association that is a first in the State of California. The certification covers 6 areas of environmental compliance and improvement. We feel we are the leading Ready Mix Producer in the field of environmental compliance.

We have a state of the art concrete plant that is second to none. Built to the expectations of increased environmental concerns we reclaim more left - over concrete than anyone. Our commitment to the environment speaks for itself. We were some of the first Carl Moyer partners that put new engines into older vehicles to stay ahead of the new regulations coming down the pike.
