Top 5 Priorities for the LCFS Advisory Panel

- 1. To ensure that the low carbon fuel standard is implemented in a manner that is as user-friendly as possible for obligated parties to comply.
- 2. To ensure that compliance mechanisms are (a) equitable, (b) reasonable, and (c) easy to understand.
- 3. To advocate for joint participation between obligated parties and biofuels producers.
- 4. To record the input, opinions and issues of all stakeholders (e.g. obligated parties, biofuels producers, State of California, citizens) and to rank in some fashion for future consideration/resolution by the ARB
