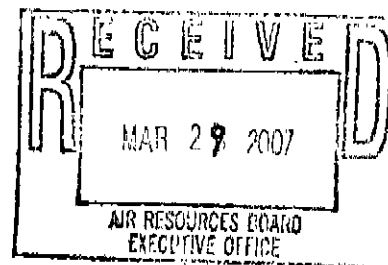

Dear Senator Maldonado,


