- Early Release of SOON Solicitation for Projects – November 2007
- South Coast AQMD Governing Board Opted Into the SOON Program on May 2, 2008
- Second Round of SOON Solicitation for Projects – Closed November 2008
- Worked Closely with CARB Staff on SOON Implementation Guidelines – Approved June 2008

**SOON Program Awards
(as of January 2009)**

- Funding Category: Off-road equipment-(dozers, scrapers, etc.)
- No. of Fleets: 22
- No. of Engines: 154
- Emissions Reductions: 348 tons/yr NOx
- Funding Amount: \$ 16,692,568

(To Be Considered – February 2009)**

- No. of Fleets: 10
- No. of Engines: 56
- Emissions Reductions: 83.6 tons/yr NOx
