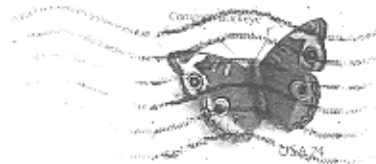
Please move assertively to protect Californians from the danger of toxic perchloroethylene.
