

Dear Chairwoman Nichols:

I am pleased to express my support for CARB's efforts to implement SB 375, which will aid in developing more sustainable communities and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

If efforts succeed to roll back AB 32 and, by extension, SB 375, the communities within the County's First Supervisorial District, which I represent, will be negatively impacted.
