On behalf of 4,565 concerned activists from all over California, we ask the California Air Resources Board to revise the draft plan for implementing AB 32, California Global Warming Solutions Act, to include more aggressive measures to fight global warming. The petition states that,


Thank you for writing your draft recommendations for implementing AB 32, the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006. This is an important first step in the fight against climate change, and I appreciate your work.

However, additional steps need to be taken beyond your recommendations. As you revise this draft, I ask that you include measures that will: 1) explicitly call for the auctioning of emissions permits, which would require big polluters to pay for their share of pollution; 2) lessen the amount of vehicle travel in California; 3) increase the rate of production of emission-free vehicles.

These important changes will help reverse the catastrophic course of climate change for the sake of all Californians. Thank you for your consideration.
