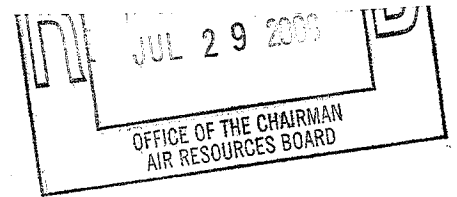

Dear Ms. Nichols:

It is urgent that we halt global warming, and for that reason I ask you to examine and adopt the timeline of AB 32, which sets a goal of rolling back emissions of greenhouse gases to 1990 levels by 2020. Automobile traffic must be reduced, and industries must not be given "permits to pollute." If they do pollute, they should be charged strict fines, which should go to promote clean energy.

We should require zero emissions of gaseous waste from industrial, commercial, agricultural, and residential activities. We should also apply strict standards of energy efficiency to any new development, including the reduction of automobile traffic, and the use of alternate transportation.

In order to achieve an 80% reduction of greenhouse gases by 2050, we must require the production of electricity to conform to standards of zero emissions. California needs to adopt a policy of 100% renewable energy for all of its electricity.

Please act now to prevent global warming.
