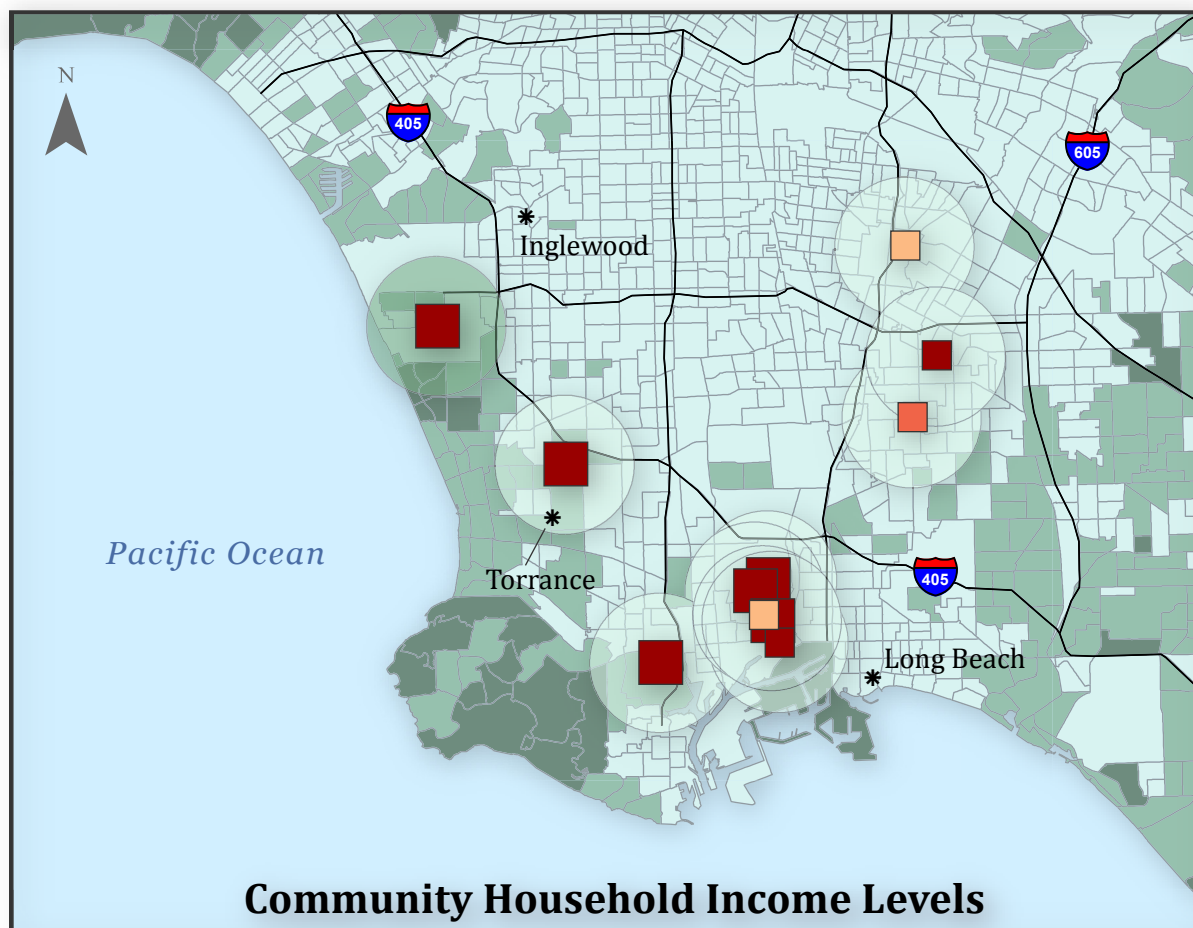
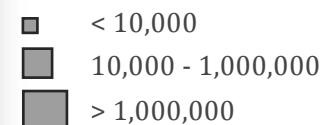

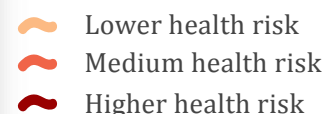


Petroleum Refineries in Los Angeles

CO₂ Emissions (tons, 2004)



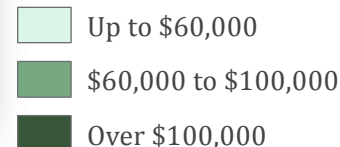
Health Risk

Census Estimates (based on 2000 Census)

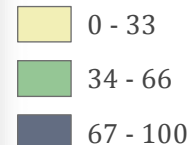
Median Household Income (in dollars)*
