**RE: Public Health Support for Strong Clean Car Standards**

Dear Chairman Nichols and Air Resources Board members:

The undersigned members of California's public health and medical community are writing to voice our support for your board seizing this historic opportunity to improve air quality and public health for generations to come. The upcoming vote by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) on the package of advanced clean cars regulations is a critical public health decision and we stand in support of California's leadership to enact the strongest vehicle emission and technology standards possible.

As health and medical organizations, we are extremely concerned about the public health crisis caused by air pollution in our communities from vehicle emissions, including illnesses and premature death from lung cancer, asthma attacks, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, heart attacks, strokes, and increased hospitalizations from breathing problems. The American Lung Association in California report, *Road to Clean Air* found that by setting the strongest possible clean car standards to reduce emissions, California could avoid over \$7 billion in annual health and other societal costs, while also avoiding 400 premature deaths, over 8,000 asthma attacks, and over 36,000 lost school and work days each year.

California's clean cars program will create the next generation of low polluting vehicles to make our state a global leader in clean car technology and protect public health. As such, we support all components of the advanced clean cars program, including the **Low Emission Vehicle/ Criteria Pollutant Regulation, the Low Emission Vehicle/GHG Regulation, the Zero Emission**

**Vehicle Regulation and the Clean Fuels Outlet Regulation** to meet our long term air pollution and greenhouse gas reduction goals. This package of regulations is critical to bolster California's transition from petroleum to cleaner transportation energy sources and ensure that cleaner fuels are readily available in California. In addition, we urge you to take the following actions to further strengthen the proposals for criteria pollutants and ZEVs:

**Low Emission Vehicle Criteria Pollutants:** We strongly support the proposed standards for ratcheting down on smog-forming gases and fine particulate pollution, however we urge you to speed up the pace of compliance with the particulate matter standard. As proposed, the fine particulate standard (1 mg per mile) would not begin to be phased in until 2025 and not fully realized until 2028. Instead, we urge full implementation of the standard by 2025.

**Zero Emission Vehicle Program:** We commend CARB for proposing to strengthen the zero emission technology mandate to require over one million zero emission vehicles by 2025. A strong technology mandate is critical to transitioning away from harmful fossil fuels and toward a more sustainable, clean air future. However, we urge you to carefully review the provision that allows car companies to reduce the numbers of zero emission vehicles if they achieve a sufficient level of over-compliance with the greenhouse gas reduction requirements. CARB must remain focused on achieving the highest possible numbers of zero-emission vehicles on the road over the next fifteen years in order to meet our clean air and climate goals. We urge you to limit this provision to reduce impacts to California's vital ZEV program. We urge you to ensure the greatest possible achievement of clean air, climate and clean technology benefits through the ZEV program.

We are pleased that California is finally moving forward to adopt this package of regulations to dramatically increase the numbers of clean, low carbon vehicles on the road in California and to require fuel providers to support the growing market for zero emission vehicles. Our organizations support the strongest possible standards and the work of the Air Resources Board to accelerate the next generation of cleaner, pollution-free cars.



## Health and Medical Support for Strong California Clean Car Programs

The undersigned public health and medical professionals strongly support California's efforts to reduce air pollutants and greenhouse gases from motor vehicles and urge the State of California to continue its national and international leadership in promoting clean vehicle policies and technologies. Without strong action to reduce emissions, global warming will exacerbate our existing air pollution-related public health crisis.

We are deeply concerned about the poor health outcomes caused by air pollution that is driven largely by transportation emissions in California. Along with triggering asthma attacks, exposure to vehicle pollution contributes to new asthma cases, impairs lung function and development and contributes to respiratory and cardiac illnesses and even premature deaths. Global warming will add to these burdens as higher temperatures lead to reduced air quality, more intense heat waves, increased wildfire smoke exposure and other public health challenges. We are especially concerned about low-income communities and other vulnerable populations including seniors, children and infants and those already suffering from lung, heart and other chronic diseases.

We support the leadership of the State of California in its ongoing efforts to implement policies and programs that reduce greenhouse gas emissions while also advancing public health, air quality and environmental goals.

Without strong action to reduce emissions, global warming will exacerbate our existing air pollution-related public health crisis.

We are deeply concerned about the poor health outcomes caused by air pollution that is driven largely by transportation emissions in California. Along with triggering asthma attacks, exposure to vehicle pollution contributes to new asthma cases, impairs lung function and development and contributes to respiratory and cardiac illnesses and even premature deaths. Global warming will add to these burdens as higher temperatures lead to reduced air quality, more intense heat waves, increased wildfire smoke exposure and other public health challenges. We are especially concerned about low-income communities and other vulnerable populations including seniors, children and infants and those already suffering from lung, heart and other chronic diseases. According to the American Lung Association in California, strong standards for new cars could avoid at least \$7.2 billion per year in health, climate and societal costs and reduce all major air pollution-related health impacts by 70 percent.

We support the leadership of the State of California in its ongoing efforts to implement policies and programs that reduce greenhouse gas emissions while also advancing public health, air quality and environmental goals.

We support the American Lung Association in California's recommendations that the California Air Resources Board must adopt strong Advanced Clean Car Standards that will include the following requirements for new cars by 2025:

- Achieve a 75 percent reduction in smog-forming emissions and place stringent controls on particle pollution from vehicles
- Achieve, at minimum, an overall 45 percent (6 percent per year starting in 2017) reduction in greenhouse gas emissions from vehicles
- Achieve a new car fleet mix that includes at least 20 percent zero emission vehicles

We believe that the strongest possible motor vehicle emission standards are critically important for the health of California residents and, as other states and the federal government adopt California vehicle standards, for the health of all Americans.
