Inspection Locations

- *CHP commercial vehicle inspection facilities/scales*
- *SW CV terminals & landfills*
- *Random roadsides*

Penalty Schedule

Penalties will depend on the specific violation (s). Under non-compliance, the regulation states: "Any violations of this section may carry civil penalties as specified in state law and regulations, including H&S Code Section 44381." H&S Section 44381 outlines penalties that range from \$500 per day to \$25,000 per day, depending on the violation (s). However, potential penalties are not limited to those found in H&S section 44381.

Penalty Assessments

- *Each case judged individually*
- *Penalty amounts depend on circumstances:*
 - ▶ *One truck or large number of trucks?*
 - ▶ *Minor problem or major problem?*
 - ▶ *Problem caused by inadvertent oversight or deliberate attempt to circumvent the regulation?*

Notices of Violation

NOV for Non-Compliant Vehicles

Will be Issued to Vehicle Owner

Enforcement Cases

ARB staff will develop violations into enforcement cases that will be settled via the ARB's Mutual Settlement Process through its Legal Office or they will be referred to the Attorney General, District Attorney, or City Attorney.

W orkshops

ARB staff will offer compliance assistance through on site training and compliance workshops.
