Victory highlights



Spearheaded California's **Smog Check** program, which reduces 100 tons of automobile pollution every day



Won the country's first complete statewide ban of toxic perchloroethylene from **dry cleaning**



Secured a mandate that ships use **cleaner-burning fuels** within 27 miles of the California coastline



Created the **Carl Moyer Program**, which provides up to \$141 million annually to California truckers to purchase less-polluting equipment



or \$1,600 per Valley resident!


