SUBJECT: CARL MOYER PROGRAM ADVISORY GROUP PUBLIC MEETINGS

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is convening a Carl Moyer Program Advisory Group (Advisory Group) to provide input on proposed revisions to the Carl Moyer Program Guidelines. ARB staff invites all interested stakeholders to participate in the Advisory Group and its meetings.

The Carl Moyer Program provides incentive grants to reduce emissions from on-road and off-road motor vehicles and agricultural sources. The Carl Moyer Program Guidelines provide local air quality management and air pollution control districts with a framework for administering the program and selecting grant applications. ARB staff is developing proposed revisions to the guidelines which are scheduled to be presented to the Board at a public meeting in March 2008. As part of the guideline revision process, ARB has committed to convene an Advisory Group to discuss key policy issues which cannot be resolved at the public workshops and to provide input to ARB staff. ARB Board Member Sandra Berg will lead the Advisory Group. ARB staff has scheduled two Advisory Group meetings in advance of the March 2008 Board meeting. The first meeting will include a review of potential guideline changes and a discussion of the role and goals of the Advisory Group. The first meeting will also be used to identify a list of policy issues for the Advisory Group to discuss. The second meeting would focus on a prioritized set of those issues identified at the first meeting.
