Meeting Information: The meeting will focus on coordination among California's air quality incentive programs, including updates on proposed changes to guidelines for the Carl Moyer Program, Lower-Emission School Bus Program, and Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program to be considered by ARB at the March 25, 2010 Board Meeting. The Group will also discuss the future of incentive programs in California as fleet regulations continue to take effect, thereby shrinking the pool of potential incentive projects. The Advisory Group will start a dialogue on potential program changes to ensure the long-term viability of California's air quality incentive programs.

There will be short presentations to kick off each agenda item, but we intend to reserve most of the time for stakeholder discussion. A tentative meeting agenda is enclosed.
