The California Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is pleased to announce its grant solicitation for the \$1 million Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement (LGER) Project. The LGER Project was approved by the Board as part of the AB 118 Air Quality Improvement Program Funding Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-11 and provides rebates or vouchers of up to \$250 for the purchase of new cordless zero-emission lawn and garden equipment in California.

This solicitation is open to all air districts designated as non-attainment of the federal 8-hour ozone standard. Applications are due to ARB by December 3, 2010.
