The California Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is pleased to announce its grant solicitation for the \$500,000 Advanced Technology Demonstration Project for the demonstration of cordless zero-emission commercial lawn and garden equipment. The Advanced Technology Demonstration Project was approved by the Board as part of the AB 118 Air Quality Improvement Program Funding Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-11.

California based public agencies such as air districts, state or local government entities, or agencies with expertise implementing demonstration programs and the requisite knowledge of commercial lawn and garden equipment may apply via this solicitation to become the demonstration project grantee.
