The California Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is pleased to announce its grant solicitation for the \$800,000 Advanced Technology Demonstration Project for technologies that meet the Ultra Low-Emitting Locomotive emission level, with the anticipation that projects will reduce emissions to the Ultra Low Emitting Locomotive emission level or below. The Advanced Technology Demonstration Project was approved by the Board as part of the AB 118 Air Quality Improvement Program Funding Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-11.

California based public agencies such air district, ports, state or local government entities or agencies with expertise implementing demonstration programs and the requisite knowledge of locomotive operations may apply via this solicitation to become the demonstration project grantee.
