The California Air Resources Board (CARB) invites interested parties to participate in a public workshop on Wednesday, April 11, 2018, in El Monte, California, to discuss the need for amendments to on-road motorcycle emissions standards and certification procedures. The purpose of the workshop is to discuss how motorcycles impact California's air quality, and to lay out potential strategies that may be employed to achieve needed emission reductions from motorcycles. Staff will also present technical and regulatory advancements that have occurred globally in the motorcycle sector, and discuss how those advancements might be applied in California.
