THE CARL MOYER MEMORIAL AIR QUALITY STANDARDS
ATTAINMENT PROGRAM:
FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2013-14 (YEAR 16S) SPECIAL FUNDS

The Air Resources Board (ARB) anticipates a return of up to \$120,000.00 in project funds from districts implementing the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program or Program). This memo invites applications for the available funds, in any amount up to \$120,000.00. Please note:

- *This solicitation is separate from the regular Moyer Year 16 solicitation, and has a separate application.*
- *No administration funds are available with these special project funds. These funds also do not have a match requirement.*
- *An application must demonstrate the air district's ability to expend the amount requested on eligible Carl Moyer Program projects within one year.*
- *Because the returned funds are from rural districts, preference will be given to rural district applications for these funds. A phone conference will be held with applying districts if the total funds applied for exceed the funds available.*

To apply for a special funds grant award, a district must submit the following:

- Application** – A completed application form (see Attachment 1), signed and dated by the district Air Pollution Control Officer or authorized designee, must be returned by January 3, 2014. Applications are needed only from districts who wish to be considered for this limited funding.
- Project List** – The application must include a description of a project or projects eligible under the Carl Moyer Program that can be funded within one year of grant execution, which will occur in early 2014. This is necessary to

ensure the expedited expenditure of funds specified under Health and Safety Code section 44299.2(c)(3).

- District Board Resolution – The district board resolution must include language that accommodates these funds and commits to follow the requirements of the Program. Because the amount of funds to be allocated to the district is uncertain, an exact amount of funds should not be specified in the resolution, but a “not-to-exceed” amount may be specified. Because district board agendas may not immediately accommodate this item, resolutions will be accepted up to April 30, 2014. Applications without a resolution must list the date that the board is scheduled to hear the item.
- Policies and Procedures Manual – Please confirm that an up-to-date version of the district’s Policies and Procedures manual is maintained at the district office. Any changes to a district’s most recently approved manual need not be submitted with the application.
