SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOPS TO DISCUSS USAGE AND EMISSIONS FROM
RED STICKER OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) invites you to participate in a series of public workshops to learn about upcoming ARB studies to better understand the usage and emissions associated with red sticker off-highway recreational vehicles (OHRV). The results of these studies, which are scheduled to begin in early 2014, will help inform ARB staff as they consider options for reducing evaporative and exhaust emissions from these vehicles. The workshops will consist of a one-hour presentation by staff, followed by a question and answer session.
