SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP NOTICE TO DISCUSS COSTS AND EMISSION INVENTORY METHODOLOGIES FOR THE PROPOSED REGULATION FOR IN-USE ON-ROAD HEAVY-DUTY DIESEL-FUELED VEHICLES (PROPOSED REGULATION)

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) staff invites you to participate in a series of workshops to discuss the methodology that ARB staff is planning to use to estimate the costs attributed to the proposed regulation and to update the emission inventory.

These workshops will primarily be a technical discussion on these methodologies, and the proposed regulation will not be discussed at these meetings. Additional workshops to discuss potential future changes to the proposed regulation are being planned for early August.

At the workshops, staff plans to discuss the methods and inputs that are being used to estimate the costs and economic impacts associated with the proposed regulation. Staff also will discuss planned updates to the emissions inventory, including changes to the current and projected statewide vehicle population, age distribution, vehicle usage, and the resulting emissions estimates. The workshops to discuss the cost and inventory methodologies will be held in Fresno, El Monte, and Sacramento at the dates and times are listed below.
