To: Public, Interested Community Members, Government Officials, and Industry Representatives

The staff of the California Air Resources Board (ARB) invites you to participate in public consultation meetings to discuss developing a control measure for reducing emissions from on-road-heavy-duty-diesel-fueled trucks dedicated to goods movement at California ports. Diesel fueled vehicles at the ports emit diesel particulate matter (PM) and other pollutants that increase health risk to nearby residents.

Port operations are also sources of oxides of nitrogen which contribute to the formation of regional smog, or ozone, and fine PM. In order to address these concerns, ARB staff are developing a control measure to reduce emissions from diesel trucks servicing the California ports. The public consultation meetings will be held at the times and locations shown below:
