

DOORS Change Log (last update 4/21/2009)

- 4/21/09 – “View Fleet Summary”** – added a fleet average and targets table to this screen.
- 4/19/09 – “Report Stolen Vehicle”** – added this screen to allow fleet owners to record information on stolen vehicle. Some of this info may be made available to law enforcement and the public via a public screen yet to be built.
- 4/18/09 – “Certificate of Reported Compliance”** – added this screen to allow fleet owners to print the Certificate of Reported Compliance.
- 4/18/09 – “See Fleet Family”** – added this screen to allow fleet owners to see parent companies, children (subsidiaries), and other corporate family members.
- 3/14/09 – “Compliance Plan (Test Version)”** – added these series of screens to allow fleet owners to develop compliance plans for their fleet. This version, unlike the previous version, allows the fleet owner to develop and save compliance plans, customize plans, and include hours in the fleet average calculation.
- 1/12/09 – “View VDECS”** – added this screen to allow fleet owners to see which VDECS are available for each vehicle within their fleet.
- 1/6/09 – “Upload Fleet Data”** – changed the upload parsing to accommodate the Caterpillar fleet tool. The fleet tool outputs “0” for blank vehicle/engine model years, DOORS converts the 0 to a default 1969.
- 12/10/2008 – “Compliance Plan”** – added functionality to incorporate early credit for turnover and retrofits. Now accommodates small and medium fleets as well as large.
- 12/8/2008 – “Engine Manufacturer”** – added “MITSUBISHI HEAVY INDUSTRIES, LTD.” and “PEUGEOT” as selections. **“Vehicle Manufacturer”**, added “TUG TECHNOLOGIES, INC.”, “PRINOTH”, “GREYHOUND”, “J.A. LARUE” as selections.
- 12/8/2008 – DOORS _Fleet_Data.xls, DOORS_Fleet_Date_wm.xls, “Temp Add/Edit Vehicle” screens** - Removed the option to label a vehicle as “Specialty”, until such a time as an Executive Order tracking system can be put into place.
- 12/1/2008 – “Edit Vehicle”** – added an “Unsell” link to allow user to incorporate a vehicle back into their fleet if they accidentally sell it.
- 11/21/2008 – “View Fleet Summary”** – added this screen to both the pre-ARB review and post-ARB review dropdown menu. This screen summarizes the fleet composition

and for the post-ARB review version, the turnover, repower, and other early credit fleet changes.

11/12/2008 – “Non-standard Engine Certification” – added this screen to capture Post-2007 flex-engines, Consent Decree engines, rebuilds to higher standards and other engines that may be certified to a standard different from the typical off-road engine.

11/12/2008 – “Add/Edit engine” – added “On/off-road engine” column to this screen to capture repowers with on-road engines.

11/12/2008 – DOORS_Fleet_Data.xls, DOORS_Fleet_Date_wm.xls, “Add/Edit engine” and “View fleet Info” screens – removed the “Date Repower” column from the spreadsheets and screens. The date repower is captured as an engine sale/purchase in the “Add/Edit Engine” screen after ARB review. This change will not cause problems uploading earlier versions of the DOORS spreadsheets.

11/12/2008 – “SOON, Moyer, other vehicle program” – added this screen to capture details of these programs. Vehicle program information will be listed in the fleet summary screen.

11/12/2008 – “Add/Edit Vehicle”, “Add/Edit Engine”, “Non-diesel Engine” screens – moved the “non-diesel” designation from vehicle to engine. Added the “Non-diesel Engine” screen to capture non-diesel engine certification standards. Note: Did not move the “non-diesel” designation from the temp vehicle screen to temp engine screen or change the spreadsheets. Instead, when ARB reviews the data, the designation is moved to the engine screens; this avoids compatibility issues with earlier versions of the DOOR spreadsheets.

11/10/2008 – DOORS_Fleet_Data.xls, DOORS_Fleet_Date_wm.xls, and “Temp Add/Edit Owner”, “Add/Edit Owner”, “View Owner Info”, “Edit Owner”, “Systems replacing diesel vehicles” screens – removed the yes/no for “Stationary or portable in place of diesel” from the spreadsheets and screens. The fleet owner will need to add system information after ARB has reviewed their fleet data in the “Systems replacing diesel vehicles screens. System information will be listed in the fleet summary screen. This change will not cause problems uploading earlier versions of the DOORS spreadsheets.

11/10/2008 – DOORS_Fleet_Data.xls, DOORS_Fleet_Data_wm.xls, and “Temp Add/Edit Owner”, “Add/Edit Owner”, “View Owner Info”, “Edit Owner”, “View Fleet Summary” screens – removed the yes/no for “Will you claim credit for early actions” from the spreadsheets and screens. DOORS will assume that all fleet owners want early credit and DOORS will calculate any early credit available for all fleet owners. Credit for early action will be listed in the “View Fleet summary” screen. This change will not cause problems uploading earlier versions of the DOORS spreadsheets.
