

How to Look Up DOORS Public Information

The public may access DOORS information about a vehicle with an equipment identification number (EIN) or check if a company has received their annual Certificate of Reported Compliance. This user guide provides an easy step-by-step guide to finding this information.

On 12/26/2007, the Air Resources Board (ARB) adopted a regulation to reduce diesel particulate matter (PM) and oxides of nitrogen (NOx) emissions from in-use (existing) off-road heavy-duty diesel vehicles in California. Such vehicles are used in construction, mining, and industrial operations.
