

Vehicle Information Page

This guide provides the definitions for the information required on the ‘Enter Vehicle’ page of the Diesel Off-road Online Reporting System (DOORS), which is the reporting system for the In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation (Off-Road Regulation). Below is a screen shot of the ‘Enter Vehicle’ page, and below is a table that provides a description/definition for each field.

Note: You will only be able to report vehicle information if you have already entered the owner information (on the ‘Edit Owner’ page).

To add a new vehicle, enter a new serial number or if the vehicle serial number is unknown leave blank.

Field	Definition
Veh serial num	<p>The vehicle serial number of the vehicle. For two-engine vehicles with on-road engines, please enter the VIN.</p> <p>The vehicle serial number should be available on the vehicle label, a bill of sale, or other records. Vehicle serial numbers may not repeat. If you have repeating serial numbers, please see the ‘How to Report with Repeating Serial Numbers’ DOORS User Guide which is available at http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/ordiesel/documents/doors/userguide-serialnum.pdf.</p>
Your veh num	An optional field for a personal vehicle identifier, or a license plate.
Type	The vehicle type field has a dropdown menu with categories of vehicles. You must select one category from the list to describe the vehicle.
Manufacturer	The vehicle manufacturer field has a dropdown menu with vehicle manufacturers listed. Check the different variations of your manufacturer name. For example, if you do not find “John Deere”, look for “Deere”. If your vehicle manufacturer is not listed, choose “OTHER”.

Field	Definition
Model	The vehicle model should be listed on the vehicle or the instruction manual.
MY (Model Year)	The vehicle model year refers to the year in which the vehicle was manufactured. This model year will not be used to calculate engine emissions; the engine model year will be used instead.
Emergency	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is used solely for emergency operations. Otherwise, select “No”.</p> <p>If a vehicle is used solely for emergency operations, it must be reported and labeled, but will have no other requirements under the Off-Road Regulation.</p>
Snow removal	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is a dedicated snow removal vehicle. Otherwise, select “No”.</p> <p>If a vehicle is considered a dedicated snow removal vehicle if it is operated exclusively to remove snow from public roads, private roads, or other paths from which snow must be cleared to allow on-road vehicle access. Privately-owned dedicated snow removal vehicles <u>must</u> have permanently affixed snow removal equipment such as a snow blower or auger; however, a publically owned vehicle is not required to have a permanently affixed attachment. Dedicated snow removal equipment must be reported and labeled, but will have no other requirements under the Off-Road Regulation.</p>
<p>Agriculture*</p> <p>*For vehicles used more than 50% of the time (but not solely) for agricultural operations, the fleet must report hours of use for these vehicles each year that reporting is required.</p>	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is used more than 50% of the time, but not solely, for agricultural operations. Otherwise, select “No”.</p> <p>If a vehicle is used a majority of the time, but not solely, for agricultural operations, it must be reported and labeled, but will have no other requirements under the Off-Road Regulation.</p> <p>Vehicles used solely for agricultural operations are completely exempt from the Off-Road Regulation.</p> <p>Additionally, fleets must report the hours of use for these vehicles each year. Field	Definition
Non-diesel	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is an alternative-fueled vehicle. Otherwise, select “No”.</p> <p>A fleet may report an alternative-fueled or gasoline-powered vehicle as part of their fleet in DOORS if <u>all</u> of the following conditions are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (A) The alternative-fueled or gasoline-powered vehicle has a max horsepower (hp) of 25 hp or greater, or replaced a diesel vehicle with a max hp of 25 hp or greater; (B) The owner can demonstrate that it serves a function and performs the work equivalent to that of a diesel vehicle and is used for a purpose for which diesel vehicles are predominantly used; (C) The vehicle is used predominantly outdoors; (D) The vehicle is not already subject to the Large Spark Ignition (LSI) Engine Fleet Requirements Regulation (LSI Fleet Regulation); (E) The owner must demonstrate that the vehicle is certified to a NOx standard less than or equal to the Tier 1 NOx standard for the same hp and is less than or equal to the NOx emissions of a diesel engine of the same model year and hp; <u>and</u> (F) If the vehicle is a gasoline-powered vehicle, the owner must identify the diesel vehicle that the gasoline-powered vehicle replaced and maintain records documenting the function of the diesel vehicle that was replaced and the gasoline-powered replacement vehicle, and the dates of sale and purchase for both vehicles.
SOON	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is currently under a contract in the Surplus Off-Road Opt-In for NOx (SOON) program. Otherwise, select “No”.</p>
Moyer	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle is currently under a contract in the Carl Moyer Incentive Funding (Moyer) program. Otherwise, select “No”.</p>
Demo	<p>Select “Yes” from the drop down menu if the vehicle participated in a retrofit or other emissions reduction demonstration program aside from the SOON and Moyer programs. Otherwise, select “No”.</p>

Field	Definition
Awaiting Sale	<p>Select "Yes" from the drop down menu if the vehicle is currently awaiting sale. Otherwise, select "No".</p> <p>Vehicles in the possession of dealers, financing companies, or other entities who do not intend to operate the vehicle nor offer the vehicle for hire, that are operated only to demonstrate functionality to potential buyers or to move short distances while awaiting sale or for maintenance purposes are exempt from all requirements of the regulation, including the reporting requirements.</p>
Island	<p>Select "Yes" from the drop down menu if the vehicle is used solely on San Nicolas or San Clemente Islands. Otherwise, select "No".</p> <p>Unless and until the land use plans for the islands are changed to allow use by the general public of the islands, vehicles used solely on San Nicolas or San Clemente Islands are exempt from all requirements of the regulation, including the reporting requirements.</p>
Loan	<p>If a vehicle is not subject to the Off-road Regulation, but is required to obtain an Equipment Identification Number (EIN) through the ARB/California Capital Access Program (CalCAP) loan program, use the drop-down menu to select "Yes".</p>
