

Email to Aggregated DOORS Fleets Ineligible for the Captive Attainment Area Fleet Designation

Subject: Ineligible to Designate as Captive Attainment Area Fleet – Aggregated Fleets

Dear Fleet Owner/Contact:

Thank you for reporting your off-road diesel vehicles in the Diesel Off-road Online Reporting System (DOORS) for the California Air Resources Board's (ARB) In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation (Off-Road Regulation). We are contacting you because you have designated one, but not all, of your aggregated DOORS fleets as a Captive Attainment Area fleet, yet your fleet may not be eligible for that designation.

Fleets that have aggregated (i.e., combined fleet portions for compliance purposes) may only designate as a Captive Attainment Area fleet if all of the vehicles in all of the fleet portions operate exclusively in the captive attainment area. In that case, ALL fleet portions must also be designated as Captive Attainment Area fleets. If that is not the case, none of the fleet portions may be designated as or considered a Captive Attainment Area fleet. Inappropriately designating as an aggregated Captive Attainment Area fleet may lead to enforcement action for emissions violations. Additionally, if the vehicles in the fleet are labeled with equipment identification numbers (EINs) that are white on a green background, they must be re-labeled with EINs that are white on a red background immediately.

If you have indeed designated as a Captive Attainment Area fleet in DOORS inappropriately, you must change the designation in the Owner Information page of your DOORS account.
