

**Email to State and Federal DOORS Fleets Ineligible for the Captive Attainment Area Fleet Designation**

**Subject: Ineligible to Designate as Captive Attainment Area Fleet – State or Federal Fleet**

Dear Fleet Owner/Contact:

Thank you for reporting your off-road diesel vehicles in the Diesel Off-road Online Reporting System (DOORS) for the California Air Resources Board's (ARB) In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation (Off-Road Regulation). We are contacting you because you have designated your DOORS fleet as a Captive Attainment Area fleet, yet your fleet may not be eligible for that designation.

All federal (U.S. government) agency and State agency fleets are treated as large fleets, regardless of size or whether they operate exclusively within a captive attainment area. Therefore, federal and state agencies cannot be designated as Captive Attainment Area fleets. Because Captive Attainment Area fleets are treated as small fleets, designating inappropriately could result in enforcement action for emissions violations. Additionally, if the vehicles in the fleet are labeled with equipment identification numbers (EINs) that are white on a green background, they must be re-labeled with EINs that are white on a red background immediately.

If you are indeed a federal or state agency fleet, you must remove the Captive Attainment Area fleet designation in the Owner Information page of your DOORS account.
