Subject: U.S. EPA Seeks Rebate Applications for up to \$120,000 for Clean Construction Equipment

The U.S. EPA has announced a Construction Equipment Funding Opportunity, as part of the Diesel Emission Reduction Program, that will provide rebate incentives to selected eligible applicants to either retrofit or to replace their nonroad construction equipment engines.

EPA will collect applications from November 20, 2013, until January 15, 2014. Eligible applicants will be chosen by a lottery system. Eligible applicants who meet the location requirement may apply to install Diesel Particulate Filters (DPF) on Tier 2 or Tier 3 engines, or they may apply to replace unregulated or Tier 1 engines with Tier 2 or Tier 3 engines. Applicants may submit one application that includes up to five engines. These five engines can be any combination of the technology options for a total maximum of \$120,000 in rebate funding per applicant.
