EIN Label

All vehicles subject to the in-use off-road diesel vehicle regulation should be labeled with Equipment Identification Numbers (EINs) by mid-September 2009. All EINs consist of six characters - two upper case letters, one number, one upper case letter, and then two numbers (for example, "XA3D47"). The letters, I and O, and the numbers 1 and 0, are not included in EINs.

If you suspect a vehicle you observe has a fraudulent EIN, you can look up further information on the vehicle including reported owner, vehicle type, and vehicle manufacturer.

Certificate of Reported Compliance

Section 2449(l) of the in-use off-road diesel vehicle regulation provides that ARB will issue fleets a Certificate of Reported Compliance with the regulation after the initial reporting required by section 2449(g)(1). Possessing a Certificate of Reported Compliance means that a fleet has submitted initial reporting data for their fleet, in accordance with section 2449(g) of the in-use off-road diesel vehicle regulation, and that ARB staff has completed preliminary review of that data and issued Equipment Identification Numbers (EINs) to the fleet. However, it does not guarantee that the fleet is in full compliance with the regulation. You may view a [list of companies](#) that have a current ARB Certificate of Reported Compliance.

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Report a Violation Instructions

What Are Some Potential Violations?

Examples of potential violations could include excessive idling, failing to provide sales disclosure, failing to report or reporting false information. One indication of a fleet that has failed to report would be one without red and white EIN labels. After mid-September 2009, all vehicles subject to the regulation should be labeled with EINs.

What Do I Need to Know to Report the Violation?

To act on your allegation, we need you to provide as much identifying information as possible regarding the fleet owner and the details of the violation.

- Who committed the violation? (Include the fleet owner's name and/or company name, company address, and telephone number)
- When did it happen?
- How exactly did the fleet owner violate the regulation?
- How are you aware of or have knowledge of the potential violation?

May I Remain Anonymous?

Yes, however, your decision for anonymity may limit our ability to conduct a complete investigation.

What Can I Expect if I Report a Violation?

Although you may not be contacted about the matter, each report will be reviewed and investigated. For confidentiality reasons, we are not able to provide information regarding what action we have taken on any allegation reported to ARB.

Will Anyone Know I Have Reported a Violation?

No, the form is transmitted over a secure connection, and we safeguard all information against unauthorized disclosure.


