SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP REGARDING PROPOSED CONTROL MEASURE
FOR ON-ROAD HEAVY-DUTY DIESEL VEHICLES OWNED OR
OPERATED BY PUBLIC AGENCIES AND UTILITIES

Background: The Air Resources Board (ARB or the Board) is holding a public workshop to solicit comments on a new proposed diesel particulate matter (PM) control measure for "On-road Heavy Duty Diesel Vehicles Owned or Operated by Public Agencies or Utilities." This proposed control measure is part of an overall plan detailed in ARB's *Risk Reduction Plan to Reduce Particulate Matter Emissions from Diesel-Fueled Engines and Vehicles (Plan)*, which was approved by the Board in September 2000.

Since the adoption of the Plan, the Board has adopted several diesel PM control measures, including measures for urban buses, solid waste collection vehicles, stationary engines, portable engines, and transportation refrigeration units on trucks. Workshop: ARB has previously conducted workshops on this item on April 3, 2003, December 2-3, 2003, and May 17-18, 2004. The ARB staff has reviewed the comments received and, in some cases, incorporated suggested changes to the proposed regulations. Specifically, the implementation schedule has been revised, the early compliance option has been updated, and new language has been added to address the concerns of rural counties. The most current draft of the proposal will be posted on the website at least two weeks prior to the workshop at <http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/publicfleets/publicfleets.htm>.

The following dates and times have been scheduled to provide an overview of the revised draft regulations and receive public comments.
