## 2013 Good Faith Effort\* for On-Road VIP Truck Replacement Program

Type	Voucher Program	Exclusions
Covers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Equipped with a 2002 or older engine model year (EMY)</li> <li>Replace class 7-8 trucks with 2007 or newer EMY</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>GVWR 19,500 lbs. and less</li> <li>2003 or newer Engine Model Years (EMYs)</li> <li>Fleets with 4+ vehicles</li> <li>Active Drayage trucks</li> </ul>
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Operate in CA 75% of time for last two years</li> <li>Two years of CA registration (plated or IRP) and insurance records</li> <li>Own 3 or fewer diesel trucks (qualify for Small Fleet Option)</li> <li>Meets all 2013 VIP guideline requirements</li> </ul>	
Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Existing vehicle(s) must be operational</li> <li>Existing vehicle destroyed after delivery of replacement</li> <li>Report in TRUCRS by January 31, 2014 (good faith effort)</li> <li>Replacement truck delivered before July 1, 2014</li> <li>3-year contract period</li> </ul>	
Amounts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Class 7-8 Replacement \$10,000 - \$45,000</li> <li>Amount based on EMY of existing truck, annual usage, and the NOx Standard of replacement truck</li> </ul>	
Applying	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Apply before January 1, 2014</li> <li>Apply at participating dealer in a participating district</li> <li>Application submitted to local air district</li> <li>District response within 5 business days</li> <li>Keep documentation in truck/place of business (application and response letter)</li> <li>Applicant cannot have an active grant application with any other grant programs (including Proposition 1B)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Other Details</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Eligible fleets that apply before 1/1/14 and are denied also qualify for the good faith effort under the MSC 13-28 Truck &amp; Bus Advisory.</li> <li>Class 7 &amp; 8 truck replacements count toward 2014 PM compliance date</li> </ul>

Eligible small fleets that apply before January 1, 2014 will be recognized for taking a good faith effort similar to those listed in the Truck and Bus Advisory MSC 13-28. The fleet must report to ARB through the Truck Regulation Upload and Compliance Reporting System (TRUCRS) by January 31, 2014. Fleets must also keep documentation of this effort in the vehicle and place of business. **Truck Voucher Incentive Program (TVIP)**

- Meet the definition of a “Small Business” as defined by the state of California and be located in the SJ Valley
- Operate the truck annually 75% within CA and 50% within San Joaquin Valley APCD boundaries
- Equipped with a 2006 or older EMY
- Up to \$50,000 available
