CPUC Rulemaking 13-11-007

Rulemaking on Alternative-Fueled Vehicles, instituted November 14, 2013. ([link](#))

Two concurrent tracks

1. Vehicle-Grid Integration

Energy Division White Paper ([link](#))

2. Rate Revisions and Financing Opportunities

Upfront vehicle costs

Infrastructure installation



CPUC Rulemaking 13-11-007

- Workshop held December 4, 2013
 - Discuss VGI and utility role in supporting transportation electrification
 - Summary Report ([link](#))
- ALJ Ruling in June 2014 seeking an inventory of AFV proceedings, including (among others):
 - Rate Design
 - Demand Response Pilots
 - Energy Storage (V1G)
 - Electric Program Investment Charge
 - Resource Adequacy
 - Rule 21 Interconnection



CPUC Rulemaking 13-11-007

- Sub-metering Pilot approved June 26, 2014
 - Resolution E-4651 ([link](#)) modifies & approves IOU tariff terms to be conformed by July 10, 2014.
 - Prepares for year-long test the use of customer-owned meters to access TOU rates for their EV, *without* separate service.
 - Meter Data Management Agents will begin outreach for customer enrollment in September.
- Scoping Memo and Ruling filed July 16, 2014
 - Sets forth schedule, scope of the proceeding ([link](#))
 - Initiates Phase 1



CPUC Rulemaking 11-03-012

- Track 2: Low Carbon Fuel Standard
 - D.14-05-021 as modified by D.14-07-003, authorizes the IOUs to sell LCFS credits.
 - Aligns annual reporting with ARB requirements
 - Requires filing plans no later than 60 days after...
 - A subsequent Decision that will determine the mechanism for the return of LCFS revenue to customers.
