<sup>2</sup>The reduced appropriation reflects three budget reductions: \$3.2 million for an ARB budget reduction, \$6 million for the Governor's May 2002 revisions to the State Budget, and \$2 million for the Governor's December 2002 revisions to the State Budget.

<sup>3</sup>ZIP I (AB 2061, Lowenthal) funds. Factoring in pending grant applications, the demand for grants in both the ARB and SCAQMD programs has exceeded available funding by \$430,123 and \$367,000, respectively. However, we are still evaluating a group of 100 pending grant applications (\$900,000) from the SCAQMD to see if they are eligible for Lowenthal incentive grants. If they are not eligible, then \$102,877 of Lowenthal funds would remain. If they are eligible, then the ARB and the SCAQMD will work with applicants for whom no Lowenthal funds are available to ensure that they receive funding from either the second zero emission vehicle (ZEV) incentive program (ZIP II) or the ZEV incentive program for eligible fleet vehicles (Fleet ZIP).
