About the Speakers

Dr. Ed Avol, is Professor of Preventive Medicine at the University of Southern California. He is an exposure assessment and health researcher with over 37 years' experience in controlled-exposure human studies, community investigations of human health and exposure, and ambient air quality measurements. He served as Deputy Director of the Children's Health Study and is a key investigator in multiple National Institutes of Health (NIH) investigations of the effects of environmental exposures on children's respiratory and cardiovascular health. He is a recent member of several USEPA panels to review the NO_x and SO_x, PM, and O₃ ambient air standards, and has worked with numerous community and regional agencies to address air quality and health concerns regarding freeway expansions and seaport-related cargo movement issues.

Dr. Paul Roberts, Chief Scientific Officer at Sonoma Technology, Inc., has designed and managed air quality and meteorological field studies and data analysis projects for government and industry. He recently served on the EPA panel for review of the Carbon Monoxide NAAQS.

Ms. Hilary Hafner, Sr. Vice President at Sonoma Technology Inc., has been principal investigator on numerous air quality data analysis projects including ambient air monitoring network assessments conducted at the national, regional, state, and urban-area level.
