Come work for Air Resources Board, Enforcement Division as an Air Pollutions (APS)/Air Resources Engineer (ARE) in the Heavy Duty Diesel Enforcement Section –Off-Road and Goods Movement. Under the general direction of a Section Manager of the Heavy Duty Diesel Enforcement Section – Off-Road and Goods Movement, the APS/ARE is responsible for assisting with the implementation, administration, and enforcement mobile diesel enforcement programs. The individual will be responsible for analyzing empirical data, preparing accurate reports, citations, administration including court and administrative hearings, developing cases for settlement and litigation, correspondence, and must demonstrate an ability to work independently to fulfill responsibilities to the public, Board, and regulated industry. The incumbent must also have the ability to prepare and present technical briefings, demonstrate proficiency in the use of PCs and software, and demonstrate a willingness to support other ARB programs as required.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: The ideal candidate shall have a strong environmental inspection/investigation background and extensive technical and administrative credentials including knowledge in the areas of state and federal environmental standards; laws and regulations thereof; and administrative procedures. Additionally, the candidate shall be a "team player" and have excellent writing, speaking skills, preferably both in English and Spanish, and be familiar with the use of the MS office programs. Previous air district or other regulatory agency inspector experiences is a plus. There will be approximately 10% travel. This position will be performing inspections at ports and other locations. Candidates will need to pass a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) background security check and qualify for a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) as a condition of employment. Applications will be screened and only the most qualified candidates will be interviewed.
