The incumbent must also have the ability to prepare and present technical briefings, demonstrate proficiency in the use of PCs and software, and demonstrate a willingness to support other ARB programs as required. <p>DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: The ideal candidate shall have a strong environmental inspection/investigation background and extensive technical and administrative credentials including knowledge in the areas of state and federal environmental standards; laws and regulations thereof; and administrative procedures. Additionally, the candidate shall be a "team player" with excellent writing and speaking skills, and be familiar with the use of the MS Office programs. Previous air district or other regulatory agency inspector experience is a plus. Travel between 10 to 20 percent may be required. This position will be performing inspections throughout the state. Candidates will need to pass a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) background security check and qualify for a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) as a condition of employment.
