In support of the Enforcement Division's mission, the Stationary Source Enforcement Section (SSES) protects public health and the environment by maximizing reductions in emissions of air contaminants and exposure to air contaminants through the fair, consistent and comprehensive enforcement of statutory and regulatory requirements by identifying, inspecting, investigating, and assisting in the prosecution of violations of environmental laws and regulations. Travel up to 20 percent may be required.</p>
