DUTIES: <p style="text-align: center;">Due to the governor's Hiring Freeze Order, only internal Air Resources Board lateral candidates will be considered.</p> <p>Air Pollution Specialists apply scientific methods and principles to conduct special purpose air monitoring studies in support of other divisions, local air districts or sister agencies, and pesticide monitoring in support of the Department of Pesticide Regulations. The Special Purpose Monitoring Section conducts emergency response monitoring to assess public exposure. Incumbents design, use and evaluate air monitoring procedures; collect air pollutant samples and monitoring data; operate, maintain, calibrate and troubleshoot air monitoring equipment; conduct and evaluate air monitoring programs; coordinate air monitoring projects for regulatory and health risk assessment purposes; comply with both Federal and State air quality monitoring requirements. Incumbents may also represent the Air Resources Board in various joint operations, group presentations, share technical expertise, train staff, answer inquiries, prepare project protocols, project reports, and be responsible to correspond both internally and outside ARB.</p>
