<p>DUTIES:</p> <p>Due to the Governor's Hiring Freeze Order, only Internal Air Resources Board lateral candidates will be considered.</p> <p>The Regulatory Assistance Section is seeking a motivated and capable Air Pollution Specialist. The Section is responsible for working with industry, US EPA, the local air districts, and other regulatory agencies to address the needs and concerns of stationary sources in California. The successful candidate will work as part of a team to technically evaluate project proposals with air quality effects for engineering soundness, compliance with Federal, State, and local air quality regulations, and emissions reduction efficacy. The incumbent will provide the results of this evaluation to management and other interested parties in the form of oral and written reports. As a part of the Air Resources Board's overall mission to protect public health, the incumbent will also be required to work as a part of a team to identify control measures and analyze the feasibility of incorporating these measures into rulemaking projects. The rule-writing process will require the incumbent to work closely with ARB management, local air districts, US EPA, and stakeholders.</p>
