The Air Resources Board (ARB) is transmitting to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) the 2012 PM2.5 Emission Inventory Submittal to the State Implementation Plan for the Chico, CA/Butte County (partial) Planning Area developed by the Butte County Air Quality Management District (Butte County or District). The District adopted the emission inventory on September 27, 2012 and transmitted it to ARB. ARB approved the emission inventory on October 18, 2012, as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan.
