Dear Mr. Blumenfeld:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) is transmitting to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) the PM10 Implementation/Maintenance Plan and Redesignation Request for Sacramento County (Sacramento PM10 Plan or Plan) developed by the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (District).

The District adopted the Plan at a public hearing on October 28, 2010 and transmitted it with supporting documentation to ARB on November 2, 2010. ARB adopted the Plan, including a PM10 transportation conformity budget, as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan (SIP), at a public hearing on November 18, 2010.
