Dear Mr. Goldstene:

The Sacramento region was designated a “serious” nonattainment area for the 1997 federal 8-hour ozone standard and further requested re-designation to “severe” nonattainment area on February 04, 2008. The Federal Clean Air Act requires the Sacramento region to submit an attainment demonstration and reasonable further progress plan per sections 172(c) and 182(c)(2). The Sacramento Regional 8-Hour Ozone Attainment and Reasonable Further Progress Plan (Plan) was developed cooperatively and adopted by Sacramento Metropolitan AQMD, Feather River AQMD, El Dorado County AQMD, Yolo-Solano AQMD, and Placer County APCD per following schedule:

Yolo-Solano AQMD	February 11, 2009
Placer County APCD	February 19, 2009

This Plan demonstrates that the region is meeting requirements of the Clean Air Act for the 1997 8-hour ozone standard including meeting minimum emission reduction progress requirements and attaining air quality standard no later than 2018. The Plan also updates the emission inventory and established new emission budgets for transportation and general conformity. In addition, the Plan makes commitments to adopt and implement new reasonably available control measures.

Multiple copies of the Plan and the final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) were already submitted by Sacramento Metropolitan AQMD on February 9, 2009, for CARB’s approval and submittal to EPA for inclusion in the State Implementation Plan (SIP) and, therefore, are not included with this submittal. In this submittal the Placer County APCD is including signed resolution, proof of publications, public notice, and Notice of Determination for EIR filing.
