Re: Submittal of Ventura County Air Pollution Control District's (APCD) final 2014 Reasonably Available Control Technology State Implementation Plan Revision (2014 RACT SIP Revision)

Dear Mr. Corey:

Enclosed please find the submittal package for Ventura County APCD's final 2014 RACT SIP Revision. The 2014 RACT SIP Revision was adopted by the Ventura County Air Pollution Control Board on June 10, 2014. I request that you submit the 2014 RACT SIP Revision, along with the attached supporting material, to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The Ventura County APCD adopted the 2014 RACT SIP Revision to comply with provisions of the EPA's Proposed Rule to Implement the 8-Hour Ozone NAAQS (78 FR 34178; June 6, 2013), which requires moderate or higher ozone nonattainment areas to demonstrate that their current rules fulfill 8-hour ozone RACT for all control techniques guidelines (CTG) categories and all major, non-CTG sources. Furthermore, such demonstrations must be submitted as revisions to their respective state implementation plans (SIP).

The 2014 RACT SIP Revision finds that all Ventura County APCD rules that apply to ozone precursor emissions from CTG source categories fulfill RACT requirements for the 8-hour ozone NAAQS. The rules either meet RACT or significantly exceed RACT. Moreover, the 2014 RACT SIP Revision finds that all CTG sources and major non-CTG sources within District boundaries are controlled to RACT or better standards. In addition, the 2014 RACT SIP Revision includes negative declarations for all CTG categories where Ventura County has no subject sources.
