Dear Mr. Blumenfeld:

With this letter, the Air Resources Board (ARB) is submitting the San Joaquin Valley *Supplemental Document: Clean Air Act Subpart 4: The 2012 PM2.5 Plan for the 2006 PM2.5 Standard and District Rule 2201 (New and Modified Stationary Source Review)* (Supplemental Document) as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan. Previously, in my September 24, 2014 letter to you, ARB transmitted the Supplemental Document and requested U.S. Environmental Agency (U.S. EPA) parallel processing pending approval at the ARB October Board hearing.

ARB adopted the Supplemental Document on October 24, 2013 as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan. During the public comment period, ARB received no public comments. The Supplemental Document demonstrates that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District 2012 PM2.5 Plan, developed to meet the Subpart 1 general provisions of the Clean Air Act, meets the requirements under the more specific particulate matter provisions in Subpart 4.
