The Cargo Handling Equipment Regulation was adopted by the ARB in December 2005, and became effective in December 2006. The Cargo Handling Equipment Regulation is part of ARB's overall strategy for reducing emissions, and exposure to diesel particulate matter. ARB staff held an initial public workshop to present and discuss proposed amendments to the Cargo Handling Equipment Regulation on November 30, 2010.

During this second public workshop, staff will be providing additional information about the proposed amendments, draft regulatory language, and a preliminary revised cargo handling equipment emissions inventory.
